## NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF TITLE V PERMITS

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is the air pollution control agency for all of Orange County and portions of Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. This is to inform the public of the intention of the AQMD to renew the existing Title V permits previously issued to the facility listed below.

BKK Corporation operates the above closed and inactive landfill facility. Permits for the above landfill consists of gas collection systems, condensate/leachate collection systems, two flare stations, three emergency electrical generation diesel engines, a diesel storage tank, and a gasoline storage and dispensing equipment.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance, unless such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, the above facilities have submitted Title V renewal applications and requested that AQMD renew their Title V permits. The proposed permits incorporates updates to the facility information, as provided in the facility's Title V renewal application, as well as updates to all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility. As required by Title V of the federal Clean Air Act, the Title V permits include all of the emission limits, applicable requirements and operating conditions imposed on the equipment. The facilities are required to certify compliance with the Title V permits in addition to recordkeeping and mandatory reporting of any deviation from the permit conditions.

The proposed permit is available for public review at AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765,

and at the **West Covina Library**, 1601 West Covina Parkway, West Covina, CA 91790. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. **Anyone wishing to comment on the issuance of the proposed permit should submit their comments in writing by January 19, 2012.
