We are issuing an administrative amendment of the Title V Operating Permit for the Four Corners Steam Electric Station, pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §71.7(d)(1)(vi), to revise the condition II.A.2.c. We have added language to the condition to clarify that it does not become effective until the termination, revocation, or expiration of the administrative stay promulgated by U.S. E.P.A.

We have enclosed the condition II.A.2.c of the amended permit, with a clear understanding that the changes made in the permit will not affect the permit terms that became effective August 1, 2008 and expire on August 1, 2013. ## **II. Requirements for Specific Units**

### **II.A. Federal Implementation Plan Requirements [40 CFR § 49.23]**

#### **2. Emissions Limitations and Control Measures [40 CFR § 49.23(d)]**

- c. Dust. Each owner or operator shall operate and maintain the existing dust suppression methods for controlling dust from the coal handling and storage facilities. Within ninety (90) days after promulgation of 40 CFR § 49.23, the owner or operator shall submit to the Regional Administrator a description of the dust suppression methods for controlling dust from the coal handling and storage facilities, flyash handling and storage, and road sweeping activities. Within 548 days of promulgation of 40 CFR § 49.23 each owner or operator shall not emit dust with an opacity greater than 20 percent from any crusher, grinding mill, screening operation, belt conveyor, or truck loading or unloading operation. This condition only becomes effective upon the termination, revocation, or expiration of the administrative stay promulgated at 73 Fed. Reg. 67109 (Nov. 13, 2008).
