Re: Notice of Proposed Decision - Significant Title V Permit Modification F-00514-5.

Dear Mr. Rios:

Enclosed for your review and comment are the District's proposed revised Title V operating permit F-00514-5 and Statement of Basis Addendum for Woodland Biomass Power Ltd., operating at 1786 East Kentucky Ave. in Woodland, California.

This notification is given in accordance with District Rule 3.8, Section 409.1 and Section 411 (a 30-day public notice comment period and a concurrent 45-day regulatory review period) for a significant Title V permit modification. The proposed revisions are necessary due to the pending issuance of Authority to Construct (ATC) C-09-124, which has been processed in accordance with the Enhanced New Source Review requirements of District Rule 3.4, section 404. Upon request, a copy of the District's ATC and engineering evaluation are available for your review.

As proposed, ATC C-09-124 authorizes up to 25% (by weight) of creosote treated railroad ties as a fuel for the boiler operating under P-105-90(t). Per section 404.1 of District Rule 3.8, upon the implementation of ATC C-09-124, Woodland Biomass Power, Ltd. is required to request in writing that the District amend the Title V operating permit to incorporate the proposed modifications.

The notice of preliminary decision for this project will be published in the Woodland Democrat newspaper approximately 7 days from the date of this letter. Please submit your written comments concerning this project within the 45 day comment period that will begin on the date that the documents are received by your agency. The District respectfully requests notification of the date the enclosed documents are received.
