Enclosed is a copy of the proposed Title V Statement of Basis and proposed revised Title V Permit F-00454-15 for the University of California, Davis (UCD) in Davis, CA. This notification is given in accordance with District Rule 3.8, Section 409.1 (a 30-day public notice comment period) and Sections 409.1.e and 411 (a concurrent 45-day regulatory review period) for a significant Title V permit modification.

The proposed revisions will include five Authority to Construct (ATC) applications, C-09-127, C-09-128, C-09-129, C-09-139 and C-09-161 for the installation of new diesel-fired engines powering emergency generators. Copies of the District's engineering evaluations and proposed ATCs or PTO for these units are available for your review, upon request.

The ATC applications have been processed in accordance with the District's Enhanced New Source Review (NSR) requirements of District Rule 3.4, Section 404. Upon implementation of the District ATCs, UCD shall submit a written request for District action to amend the Title V Permit, in accordance with District Rule 3.8, Section 404.1.

The notice of preliminary decision for this project will be published in the Davis Enterprise newspaper approximately three days from the date of this letter. Please submit your written comments on this project within the 45-day comment period which begins on the date the proposed documents are received by your agency. The District respectfully requests notification of the date the enclosed documents are received.
