The Mojave Desert Air Quality Management District (District) has completed the Federal Operating Permit (FOP) Modification Final Determination on the proposed applications for the Slurry Lime Injection System at Mitsubishi Cement Corporation (MCC) located in Lucerne Valley. The proposed action constitutes a Minor Modification to MCC's FOP (11800001).

The comment period on the proposed applications ended on May 11, 2013. Written comments were received from USEPA on May 3, 2013. Those comments and the District response can be viewed in section (D)(1) of the NSR/FOP Final Determination Document.
