SUBJECT: National Cement Company of California, Inc. Title V Permit Renewal 45-Day Review

Dear Mr. Rios:

Pursuant to the Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District (EKAPCD) Rule 201.1 (Permits to Operate for Sources Subject to Title V (Title V) of the Federal Clean Air Act Amendment of 1990), a Federal Part 70 Permit renewal has been proposed for National Cement Company of California, Inc. located 5 Miles East of I-5 on Hwy. 138 Lebec, California 93243; mailing address: 15821 Ventura Boulevard, Suite 475 Encino, CA 91436. Portland cement is produced at this facility. EKAPCD issued an initial Title V Permit to Operate to this facility in 2001. The purpose of this permitting action is to update and renew the facility's previous Title V permit. No significant modifications have occurred to the permit, since the 2006 renewal.

The attached is a revision to National Cement Company of California's proposed Title V Permit renewal that was originally submitted to EPA on January 9, 2012 for a 45-day review. EPA had many suggested changes to the first draft. Also attached is the Technical Support Document (TSD) for the proposed Title V Permit renewal. The 30-day public review period has begun on September 20, 2012 and will run concurrently with EPA's.
