Baker Commodities, Inc. (ID 800016) has proposed to revise their Title V Permit. They modified three of their boilers to burn Yellow Grease as a back-up fuel to Natural Gas. Baker Commodities primarily renders animal matter into products such as tallow and meat meal; they also process restaurant grease and oil into yellow grease. Baker Commodities is located at 4021 Bandini Blvd., Vernon, CA 90058. This proposed permit revision is considered a "minor" permit revision to their Title V permit. Attached for your review are the evaluations and the proposed permit. With your receipt of the proposed Title V permit revision today, we will note that the EPA 45-day review period will begin on January 17, 2012.
