This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal that is engaged in the manufacturing of beverage cans. The facility operates roller coaters, printers, inside spray equipment, ovens, chemical cleaning process lines, storage tanks, a boiler, emergency internal combustion engines, a baghouse, a high efficiency particulate arresting filter, and other supporting equipment. The VOC emissions from the can manufacturing operation (roller coaters, printers, inside spray equipment and ovens) are controlled by two air pollution control equipment afterburners.

This is an existing facility applying for a Title V permit renewal that is engaged in the manufacturing of pre-pregnated and laminated products. The facility operates a coating and curing line, epoxy resin mixing and holding tanks, two boilers, five storage tanks, and other supporting equipment. The VOC emissions from the coating and curing line are vented to an air pollution control equipment afterburner.

Pursuant to Title V of the federal Clean Air Act and AQMD Rule 3004(f), a Title V permit shall expire five years from the date of issuance unless

such permit has been renewed. Accordingly, each of the above facilities has submitted a Title V renewal application and requested the AQMD to renew their Title V permit. Each of the proposed permits incorporates updates to the facility information provided in the facility's Title V renewal application and all rules and regulations that are currently applicable to the facility.

The proposed permits are available for public review at the AQMD, 21865 Copley Dr., Diamond Bar, CA 91765 and at the Los Angeles Public Library, Science, Technology, and Patents Department, 630 West 5th Street, Los Angeles, CA 90071. Information regarding the facility owner's compliance history submitted to the AQMD pursuant to California Health & Safety Code Section 42336, or otherwise known to the AQMD based on credible information, is also available from the AQMD for public review. Comments must be received by September 7, 2009. The AQMD will consider all public comments and may revise the Title V permit in accordance with AQMD rules and regulations.

The public may request the AQMD to conduct a public hearing on any of the proposed permits by submitting a Hearing Request Form (Form 500-G) to Hamed Mandilawi at the above AQMD address. The AQMD will hold a public hearing if there is evidence that the proposed permits are not correct or are not adequate to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements, and a hearing will likely provide additional information that will affect the drafting and/or issuance of the permits.
