

TITLE V PERMIT ISSUANCE REPORT

Purpose:

The District has prepared this Title V Permit Issuance Report to document that Title V Permit F-00012-9 is being finalized to incorporate all of the proposed changes to the facility's current Title V Permit F-00012-9 (issued on August 15, 2011). The changes reflect the revised operating conditions of Authorities to Construct (ATC's) C-11-76 (Tank #15), C-11-77 (Tank #16) and C-11-78 (Tank #18), which have been implemented into Permits to Operate (PTOs) P-54-93(a5), P-66-93(a2), and P-45-94(a3), respectively.

The project was considered a significant modification requiring a 45-day regulatory review from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the California Air Resources Board (CARB), and a concurrent 30-day public noticing period. As summarized in the "Addendum" to Emission Evaluations C-11-76, C-11-77 and C-11-78 (see attached), the District did not receive any comments from U.S. EPA, CARB, or the public prior to issuing the ATCs.

EPA Comments:

The U.S. EPA comment period began on November 8, 2011 - when the District emailed Region IX the documents associated with the above listed ATCs and Proposed Title V Permit F-00012-9 (processed under Enhanced New Source Review). On December 22, 2011, Roger Kohn confirmed via email that U.S. EPA would not be providing the District with any comments on this project (see file).

ARB Comments:

The ARB comment period began on November 8, 2011 - when the District emailed the Project Assessment Branch the documents associated with the above listed ATCs and Proposed Title V Permit F-00012-9. On November 15, 2011, Evan Powers confirmed via email that ARB would not be providing the District with any comments on this project (see file).

Public Comments:

The public notice for this significant modification was published on November 9, 2011, in the West Sacramento Press newspaper (see file for proof). The 30-day noticing period ended on December 9, 2011. The District did not receive any comments from the public or the source during this period.

Recommendation:

During the Permit to Operate (PTO) issuance inspections, it was discovered that a minor note of clarification was needed in the visual tank inspection condition listed below. The identical condition is share by all three PTO's and the Title V, and has been revised to

specify that the visual inspection of the floating roof is to be conducted when the internal floating roof is at least four feet from the viewport or access hatch.

Revised Condition 34 of PTO P-54-93(a5), Condition 35 of PTO P-66-93(a3), Condition 31 of PTO P-45-94(a2), and Title V Permit Condition II.C1.2 now read:

"The Permit Holder shall visually inspect the secondary seal, floating roof, and deck fittings and use an explosimeter that is calibrated in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications to measure the LEL of the storage tank. For each storage tank, inspections and measurements shall be completed at least once every 3 months with the internal floating roof at a distance of no less than 4 feet from the storage tank viewport or access hatch. Any of the conditions described in 40 CFR Part 63.1063(d)(1)(i) through (d)(1)(iv) shall constitute an inspection failure. Identification of holes or tears in the rim seal is required only for the seal that is visible from the top of the storage vessel. [District Rule 2.21, '502.2(a), 40 CFR Part 63.1063(c)(1)(i)(A) and (d)(2), and 40 CFR Part 63.11092(e)(1)]"

As such, issue Title V Permit F-00012-9 with the above mentioned revision.



SUMMARY:

I spoke with Roger Kohn to confirm the regulatory dates for Buckeye Terminals, LLC Enhanced New Source Review project (ATC's C-11-76, C-11-77, C-11-78, and proposed significant modification Title V Permit F-00012-9). I informed him that I had emailed the documents to Gerardo Rios and Amy Parsley on November 8, 2011, and then forwarded him a copy of the email to verify the submittal. Roger informed me that Amy was not be available to review the project and would be out of the office until March 2012.

After reviewing the email, he confirmed that EPA's 45-day review period began on November 8 and would end on December 23, 2011. He said that he did not plan on providing comments for this particular project, and would be providing me with an email saying so on Friday (December 23rd).

I later called him back and asked if we could end the 45-day comment period one day early in order to accommodate for vacations due to the Christmas weekend. Roger agreed and said he would provide me with a "no comment" email on December 22nd.


