The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) has reviewed your Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM) Plan dated February 26, 2015. In accordance with requirements in 40CFR64, your facility submitted this plan for Executive Officer approval. This plan includes a reasonable assurance that compliance with emissions limits is continuously met by control devices used to comply with applicable emissions requirements. Monitoring is conducted using either direct monitoring of emissions, or other parameters that would indicate effective use of the control device. The following equipment is covered in the CAM plan.

- P3S2 Fluid Catalytic Cracking Unit (FCCU) (D96) with associated PM10 control devices, Electrostatic Precipitators (C1575, C1576 and C1577)

Based on the information submitted, your 40CFR64 CAM Plan has been reviewed and approved, subject to the following conditions and definitions:

COMPLIANCE ASSURANCE MONITORING (CAM) PLAN CONDITIONS for the Electrostatic Precipitators (C1575, C1576 and C1577) Subject to this Plan Application:


The operator shall operate and maintain all equipment subject to CAM according to the following requirements:

1. The operator shall comply with all applicable operating and monitoring conditions and requirements referenced in Section D or H of the Title V permit.

2. All exceedances (as defined in equipment-specific definitions below) shall be reported to the AQMD pursuant to the requirements specified in 40 CFR Part 64.9 and Condition Nos. 22 and 23 of Section K of this permit. The semi-annual monitoring report shall include the total operating time of this equipment and the total accumulated duration of all deviations for each semi-annual reporting period specified in Condition No. 23 in Section K of this permit. All prompt reporting shall be as defined in Condition No. 22 in Section K of this permit.
3. The operator shall submit an application for a Quality Improvement Plan (QIP) in accordance with 40 CFR Part 64.8 to the SCAQMD if an accumulation of exceedances for any applicable control device exceeds the number specified below.
4. The operator shall inspect and maintain all equipment components and associated monitoring equipment on an annual basis in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications.
5. The operator shall keep adequate records in a format that is acceptable to the SCAQMD to demonstrate compliance with all applicable requirements specified in this condition and 40CFR Part 64.9 for a minimum of five years.
6. For the purpose of this CAM plan, an exceedance shall be defined as when the ESP daily average voltage and current or total power input falls below the most recent source tests which demonstrated compliance with the emission limits and a new source test is not performed within 90 days at the new minimum daily average ESP total power level that demonstrates compliance with the emission limit. If the number of exceedances exceed six(6) for any semi-annual reporting period specified in Condition No. 23 in Section K of this permit, the required QIP shall be submitted to the SCAQMD within 90 calendar days after the due date for the semi-annual monitoring report.
