Proposed Minor Revision to Title V Permit for Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA), Regional Plant No. 1 (ID# 009163)

Enclosed for your review is the proposed revision to the Title V Permit for IEUA, Regional Plant No. 1 located at 2450 Philadelphia Avenue, Ontario, CA. This revision is considered to be a Minor permit revision, and a public notice is not required. IEUA has received financing from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act through the State Water Resources Control Board and is ready to move forward with improvement projects including construction of a centrifuge sludge dewatering facility. Due to the urgency of this construction project, we respectfully request your expedited review of this proposal on or before October 22, 2009. We are enclosing complete proposed Section H, including the revised permit as shown below, and the engineering evaluation.



501289	Sewage Treatment Facility, (> 5 MGD), Anaerobic	Alteration of Sewage Treatment Plant by addition of a centrifuge sludge dewatering.
501290	Biofilter (> 100 cfm)	Modification of the biofilter by addition of the centrifuge sludge dewatering building exhaust to the biofilter.

The initial Title V permit for this facility was issued on August 1, 2008. Since then, the facility filed these applications as described above.

There will be no increase in the emissions from the proposed modification to the sewage treatment plant or the biofilter. This project has been designated by the US EPA as a Green Project due to the Energy Efficiency and Environmental Innovative criteria.
