In response to your request, dated December 27, 2004, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX, (EPA) hereby grants to the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) formal delegation of the following National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), as they existed on July 1, 2004:



EPA is also granting to NDEP delegation of amendments to 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart YYYYY (Stationary Combustion Turbines) which were published in the Federal Register on August 18, 2004, as well as 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart DDDDD (NESHAP for Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional Boilers and Process Heaters) as promulgated in the Federal Register on September 13, 2004. We understand that these subparts were adopted as temporary regulations by the State Environmental Commission on November 30, 2004, pending adoption as permanent amendments. Regarding any NESHAP previously delegated to NDEP, this letter is also delegating any amendments made to those NESHAP as of July 1, 2004.

These NESHAP are being delegated in accordance with the September 3, 1997, Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection and EPA regarding the delegation of NESHAP. As set forth in the MOA, these delegations are effective upon the date of this letter and EPA will publish a future Federal Register notice to codify these delegations into the Code of Federal Regulations.

We appreciate NDEP's efforts to implement the federal air toxics program and hope to continue working with you to reduce emissions of air toxics in Nevada. If you have any questions about this delegation, please call me at (415) 947-8715 or have your staff contact Mae Wang at (415) 947-4124.
