In response to your request of February 19, 1992, I am pleased to inform you that we are delegating to your agency authority to implement and enforce certain categories of New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) on behalf of the **San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (SDCAPCD)**. We have reviewed your request for delegation and have found the SDCAPCD's programs and procedures to be acceptable. This delegation includes authority for the following source category:

EPA will retain independent enforcement authority, and will exercise such authority in a manner consistent with EPA's timely and appropriate
