Dear Mr. Shifley:

In response to your request of January 28, 1993, I am pleased to inform you that we are delegating to your agency authority to implement and enforce the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) category in **40 CFR Part 60: Subpart UUU - Standard of Performance for Calciners and Dryers in Mineral Industries**. We have reviewed your request for delegation and have found your present programs and procedures to be acceptable.

Acceptance of this delegation constitutes your agreement to follow all applicable provisions of 40 CFR Part 60, including use of EPA's test methods and procedures. As of the effective date of this delegation, Nevada Department of Conservation and Natural Resources will have primary authority to enforce the above standard. EPA will retain independent enforcement authority, and will exercise such authority in a manner consistent with EPA's timely and appropriate guidance, and our enforcement agreement. As such, all notifications and reports required of sources by the above standards should be sent to you, with a copy to our office. The delegation is effective upon the date of this letter unless the USEPA receives written notice from you of any objections within 10 days of receipt of this letter. A notice of this delegated authority will be published in the Federal Register in the near future.
