The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX, (EPA) is hereby granting to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) formal delegation of the following National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPs), as they existed on July 1, 1999:

- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart AA -- NESHAP from Phosphoric Acid Manufacturing Plants
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart BB -- NESHAP from Phosphate Fertilizers Production Plants
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart HH -- NESHAP from Oil and Natural Gas Production Facilities
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart SS -- National Emission Standards for Closed Vent Systems, Control Devices, Recovery Devices and Routing to a Fuel Gas System or a Process
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart TT -- National Emission Standards for Equipment Leaks - Control Level 1
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart UU -- National Emission Standards for Equipment Leaks - Control Level 2 Standards
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart WW -- National Emission Standards for Storage Vessels (Tanks) - Control Level 2
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart YY -- NESHAP for Source Categories: Generic MACT Standards
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart CCC -- NESHAP for Steel Pickling - HCl Process Facilities and Hydrochloric Acid Regeneration Plants
- 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart DDD -- NESHAP for Mineral Wool Production

40 CFR Part 63, Subpart PPP -- NESHAP for Polyether Polyols Production
40 CFR Part 63, Subpart TTT -- NESHAP for Primary Lead Smelting
40 CFR Part 63, Subpart XXX -- NESHAP for Ferroalloys Production: Ferromanganese and Silicomanganese.


Regarding any NESHAPs previously delegated to ADEQ, this letter is also delegating any amendments to those NESHAPs, as of July 1, 1999.

These NESHAPs are being delegated in response to your request, dated January 5, 2000 [sic], and received by our office on January 30, 2001. They are being delegated in accordance with the September 18, 1997, Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between ADEQ and EPA regarding the delegation of NESHAPs. As set forth in the MOA, these delegations are effective upon the date of this letter and EPA will publish a future Federal Register notice to codify these delegations into the Code of Federal Regulations. Your January 5, 2000 [sic] submittal also requested an updated delegation for New Source Performance Standards and 40 CFR Part 61 NESHAP. We are not taking action on these requests at this time, but intend to do so in the near future. We appreciate ADEQ's efforts to implement the federal air toxics program and hope to continue working with you to reduce emissions of air toxics in Arizona.
