Dear Mr. Aymar:

EPA is delegating to your agency authority to implement and enforce certain categories of New Source Performance Standards (NSPS). We understand that you have a lengthy adoption process, and that you intend to request delegation as soon as the regulations are certified by the Secretary of State. To speed up the process, this delegation will be effective on the date the Secretary of State certifies the regulations. However, if for some reason, the regulations are not certified, this delegation will be void. This delegation includes authority for the following source categories:

<u>NSPS</u>	<u>40 CFR</u> <u>Part 60</u>
Lead-Acid Battery Manufacturing Plants	KK
Phosphate Rock Plants	NN
Asphalt Processing & Asphalt Roofing Manufacture	UU

Acceptance of this delegation constitutes your agreement to follow all applicable provisions of 40 CFR Part 60, including use of EPA's test methods and procedures. The delegation is effective upon the date the regulations are certified by the Secretary of State. Please let us know as soon as possible what date the certification takes place. A notice of this delegated authority will be published in the Federal Register after we receive notification that the regulations have been certified.
