The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX, (EPA) is hereby granting to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) formal delegation of the following National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP):

40 CFR Part 63, Subpart S -- NESHAP from the Pulp and Paper Industry
40 CFR Part 63, Subpart LL -- NESHAP for Primary Aluminum Reduction Plants
40 CFR Part 63, Subpart EEE -- NESHAP from Hazardous Waste Combustors

These NESHAP are being delegated in response to your request, dated October 6, 1999, and in accordance with the September 18, 1997, Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between ADEQ and EPA regarding the delegation of NESHAP. As set forth in the MOA, the delegations of the NESHAP listed above are effective upon the date of this letter and EPA will publish a future Federal Register notice to codify these delegations into the Code of Federal Regulations. Your October 6, 1999, submittal also requested an updated delegation for New Source Performance Standards and 40 CFR Part 61 NESHAP. We are not taking action on these requests at this time, but intend to do so in the near future. We appreciate ADEQ's efforts to implement the federal air toxics program and look forward to continue working with you to reduce emissions of air toxics in Arizona.
