In response to your request, dated January 15, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX, (EPA) hereby grants to the Washoe County District Health Department, Air Quality Management Division (Washoe County) formal delegation of the following Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40, Part 60 (40 CFR Part 60) New Source Performance Standards (NSPS):


- Subpart TTT – Industrial Surface Coating: Surface Coating of Plastic Parts for Business Machines
- Subpart UUU- Calciners and Dryers in Mineral Industrial
- Subpart VVV – Polymeric Coating of Supporting Substrates Facilities
- Subpart WWW – Municipal Solid Waste Landfills
- Subpart AAAA – Small Municipal Waste Combustion Units for Which Construction is Commenced After August 30, 1999 or for Which Modification or Reconstruction is Commenced After June 6, 2001
- Subpart CCCC – Commercial and Industrial Solid Waste Incineration Units for Which Construction Is Commenced After November 30, 1999 or for Which Modification or Reconstruction Is Commenced on or After June 1, 2001
- Subpart EEEE – Other Solid Waste Incineration Units for Which Construction is Commenced After December 9, 2004, or for Which Modification or Reconstruction is Commenced on or After June 16, 2006
- Subpart IIII – Stationary Compression Ignition Internal Combustion Engines
- Subpart JJJJ – Stationary Sparks Ignition Internal Combustion Engines
- Subpart KKK – Stationary Combustion Turbines

Regarding any other 40 CFR Part 60 standards previously delegated to Washoe County, this letter is also delegating any amendments made to those standards as of August 8, 2008. In this letter, we are responding only to your request for delegation of 40 CFR Part 60 NSPS. You should have already received a separate letter addressing delegation of 40 CFR Part 63 Standards of National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants.

Acceptance of this delegation constitutes your agreement to follow all applicable provisions of 40 CFR Part 60, including but not limited to use of EPA's test methods and continuous emission monitoring procedures. As of the effective date of this delegation, Washoe County will have primary authority to enforce the above standards. EPA will retain independent enforcement authority, and will exercise such authority in a manner consistent with EPA's "Timely and Appropriate Enforcement Response to Significant Air Pollution Violators" Guidance, and any revisions thereto, and our enforcement agreement. All notifications and reports required of sources by the above standards should be sent to you, with a copy to our office. The delegation is effective upon the date of this letter unless the U.S. EPA receives written notice from you of any objections within 10 days of receipt of this letter. A notice of this delegated authority will be published in the Federal Register in the future.

We appreciate Washoe County's efforts to implement the federal NSPS program, and hope to continue working with you to reduce emissions of air pollutants in your area.
