In response to your request of September 16, 1986, I am pleased to inform you that we are delegating to your agency authority to implement and enforce certain categories of New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) on behalf of the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (SDCAPCD). We have reviewed your request for delegation and have found the SDCAPCD's programs and procedures to be acceptable. This delegation includes authority for the following source categories:
