In response to your request, dated January 15, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX, (EPA) hereby grants to the Washoe County District Health Department, Air Quality Management Division (Washoe County) formal delegation of the following Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40, Part 63 (40 CFR Part 63) National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP):

- Subpart VVV – Publicly Owned Treatment Works
- Subpart EEEE – Organic Liquids Distribution (Non-Gasoline)
- Subpart WWW – Reinforced Plastic Composites Production
- Subpart ZZZZ – Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines
- Subpart WWWW – Hospital Ethylene Oxide Sterilizers
- Subpart BBBB – Gasoline Distribution Bulk Terminals, Bulk Plants and Pipeline Facilities
- Subpart CCCCC – Gasoline Dispensing Facilities
- Subpart HHHHH – Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating Operations at Area Sources
- Subpart OOOOO – Flexible Polyurethane Foam Fabrication Operations Area Sources
- Subpart WWWW – Area Source Standards for Plating and Polishing Operations
- Subpart XXXXX – Area Source Standards for Nine Metal Fabrication and Finishing Source Categories

Regarding any other 40 CFR Part 63 standard previously delegated to Washoe County, this letter is also delegating any amendments made to those standards as of August 28, 2008. In this letter, we are responding only to your request for delegation of 40 CFR Part 63 NESHAP. You will receive a separate letter addressing delegation of 40 CFR Part 60 Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources.

These delegations are being granted in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) dated June 24, 1997, with an amendment dated December 16, 1998, between Washoe County and EPA regarding the delegation of NESHAP. As set forth in the MOA, these delegations are effective upon the date of this letter and EPA will publish a future Federal Register notice to codify these delegations into the Code of Federal Regulations.

We appreciate Washoe County's efforts to implement the federal air toxics program and hope to continue working with you to reduce emissions of air toxics in your area.
