Dear Mr. Boyd:

In response to your request of April 4, 1984, I am pleased to inform you that we are delegating to your agency authority to implement and enforce the National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) Category in 40 CFR Part 61: Standard of Asbestos on behalf of the Sacramento County Air Pollution Control District (SCAPCD). We have reviewed your request for delegation and have found the SCAPCD programs and procedures to be acceptable.

Acceptance of this delegation constitutes your agreement to follow all applicable provisions of 40 CFR Part 61, including use of EPA's test methods and procedures. The delegation is effective upon the date of this letter unless the USEPA receives written notice from you or the District of any objections within 10 days of receipt of this letter. A notice of this delegated authority will be published in the Federal Register in the near future.
