
By letter dated May 23, 1975, you were notified that EPA was delegating authority to implement and enforce the standards of performance for new stationary sources (NSPS) and national emission standards for hazardous air pollutants (NESHAPS) to the State of California on behalf of the Bay Area Air Pollution Control District. Condition number 3 was inadvertently omitted from the letter of delegation.

The purpose of this letter is to amend the May 23, 1975 letter of delegation on behalf of the Bay Area District by adding condition 3. The condition reads as follows:

3. Acceptance of this delegation of presently-promulgated NSPS and NESHAPS does not commit the State of California and the Bay Area Air Pollution Control District to request or accept delegation of future standards and requirements. A new request for delegation will be required for any standards not included in the State's request of January 13, 1975.

This amendment is effective immediately. If the Air Resources Board has any objection to the amendment, please notify me within 10 days of the date of receipt of this letter.
