





## EPA Will Be Dredging Sediments in Spring Creek Arm of Keswick Reservoir

### Work planned for September-December 2009 and April-May 2010

EPA will use a hydraulic dredge to remove contaminated sediments at the bottom of the Spring Creek Arm of Keswick Reservoir. The sediments contain toxic metals from the Iron Mountain Mine Superfund Site.



Work Location - Dredging will occur only in the Spring Creek Arm of the Keswick Reservoir

### Work schedule

**September 2009:** Mobilization of heavy dredging equipment in the parking lot of the Keswick Reservoir Boat Launch Ramp

**October-November 2009:** Dredging in Spring Creek Arm of Keswick Reservoir.

**April-May 2010:** Additional dredging, weather permitting. Dredging will continue **24 hours a day, 6 days a week.**

### Work impacts

Local residents and visitors will see **24-hour lighting** in the area during dredging operations. Traffic in the roadways will remain near normal.

### Keswick Boat Launch Ramp Closed

To assure safety, the Keswick Boat Launch Ramp will be closed from September 9 until mid-December, 2009, and April-May 2010.

### Safety precautions during dredging

EPA has performed extensive engineering studies and will implement safeguards to protect downstream water quality during dredging. EPA will also continuously monitor the water to assure that dredging is proceeding as expected.
