



Motorola 52nd Street Superfund Site Operable Unit Three Study Area

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in coordination with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), is investigating groundwater contamination in the Operable Unit Three (OU3) Study Area.

How Does This Affect You?

Groundwater monitoring wells will be installed during normal business hours, Monday – Friday, 7AM – 6PM, in your neighborhood beginning on:


Drilling/installations will take place near the following address:

Well installation will create noise and may impact traffic in your neighborhood; however, the work site will be roped off to protect the public from construction hazards. The well installations near you will take approximately two weeks to complete. In addition, you may hear noise from water pumps as groundwater-sampling activities occur.

Activities and Approximate Schedule

New well installation & development: October – November 2010
Well sampling: Quarterly for one year for new wells, then semi-annually.
Semi-annually for existing wells.

Project Background

This work is being done to determine the extent of the contamination. The boundaries of the Study Area are 20th Street to 7th Avenue and McDowell to Buckeye. See the September 2010 fact sheet for more information. If you did not receive a fact sheet, call the EPA message line listed below to request one.

Groundwater monitoring wells currently exist within the Study Area; however, additional monitoring wells must be installed to obtain more information. Water samples will be taken regularly from the existing and newly installed wells. These samples will be analyzed to determine the nature and extent of the groundwater contamination. EPA and ADEQ will use this information to guide the next phase of work at the site.
