Dear Resident and Property Owner:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) are continuing to direct an environmental study in Mountain View, California in connection with the former Teledyne Semiconductor and former Spectra-Physics Lasers sites located at 1300 Terra Bella Avenue and 1250 Middlefield Road.

The purpose of this study is to determine if certain chemicals (volatile organic compounds or VOCs) are migrating as vapors from groundwater into the indoor air of nearby buildings (vapor intrusion).

Please be aware that your drinking water is not affected by this contamination. Your water comes from the Hetch Hetchy Reservoir in the Sierra Nevada Mountains, not from groundwater in this area.

In January 2015 EPA knocked on your door and left an outreach letter, offering to test the indoor air in your home and others on Spring and Morgan Street to see if there is a buildup of VOCs. At that time, we did not receive any response from you.

This letter serves as formal documentation that participation in this study was offered, at no cost to you, and that permission to test the air inside your home was not granted.
