Groundwater Cleanup Construction Starts at Del Amo and Montrose Superfund Sites

In March 2013, construction work will start in this community to pump contaminated groundwater to a treatment system being built on the Montrose property (see Figure below). The work is planned to continue for a year and a half, and be finished by the end of 2014.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is overseeing this work as part of the ongoing clean up of the Del Amo and Montrose Superfund sites.

We invite you to a Community Meeting where you can learn about what will be built, where it will be built, how long it will take, and how you can follow each step of the work.

Learn about:

- The groundwater cleanup project;
- The construction, including building a groundwater treatment plant on the former Montrose Property at Normandie and Jon Street;
- Drilling the eight new wells that will pump the groundwater out and three new wells to pump treated water back underground;
- The route of the underground piping that will carry the water to and from the treatment plant.




Figure: Groundwater Remedy Infrastructure
