

EPA Finds Del Monte Site Remedy Protective

Based on the results of its Five-year Review, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) finds that the cleanup remedy for the Del Monte Corporation (Oahu Plantation) Superfund site is protective of human health and the environment.

There is no exposure to untreated shallow (perched) or deep (basal) aquifer groundwater. Additional Five-year reviews will be conducted until the former pineapple farm has been cleaned up sufficiently to allow unrestricted use.
