

EPA Amends Groundwater Remedy at the North Hollywood Operable Unit of the San Fernando Valley Area 1 Superfund Site

On January 10, 2014, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) signed a Record of Decision (ROD) Amendment to amend the 2009 Second Interim ROD for the groundwater remedy at the North Hollywood Operable Unit (NHOU) of the San Fernando Valley (SFV) Area 1 Superfund Site. On June 5, 2013, EPA held a public meeting to present the Proposed Plan and record oral comments for the public record. The public comment period ran from May 13, 2013 to July 15, 2013.

Summary of Selected Remedy

The 2013 ROD Amendment amends the Second Interim ROD by adding the option to re-inject the extracted and treated groundwater from the NHOU treatment facility. This additional option allows for the flexibility to design the most effective remedy and implement it quickly.
