## PROGRAM OUTREACH ACHIEVEMENTS: OCTOBER 2014-DECEMBER 2014

### Overview

The Navy's Community Involvement Plan (CIP) for Hunters Point Naval Shipyard (HPNS) lists several ways for the HPNS cleanup team to reach out to the HPNS community, including quarterly summaries of community involvement achievements and goals for the coming months. An update on the cleanup in Parcel C was provided by the Navy during the second part of the meeting.

## NAVY BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE (BRAC)



In 1988, the Department of Defense created the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Program to oversee the cleanup and transfer of military bases to public or private groups for redevelopment.

HPNS was added to the BRAC Program in 1988, and the Navy has been working since that time to clean up hazardous waste created by former shipyard use.

*The HPNS cleanup team includes the United States Navy, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the California Department of Toxic Substances Control, and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board.*
