GROUNDWATER MONITORING WELL INSTALLATION

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) will begin drilling to install groundwater monitoring wells in the streets near the Cooper Drum Superfund Site, in South Gate, California.

WHAT AND WHERE:

EPA will be drilling to construct 18 wells in nine locations, including five along McCallum Avenue and Duncan Avenue (see map for planned locations). The streets will remain open during these activities, but driveway access may be blocked temporarily.


Equipment for this work includes a large drill rig, one or two support trucks and a fork lift.

HOW LONG:

Approximately four weeks, beginning on April 13. Work at each new well location is scheduled to take one or two days.

WORK SCHEDULE:

Monday through Friday, typically 7 AM to 5 PM, except for a 24-hour groundwater pump test during the week of May 4.



GROUNDWATER PUMP TEST:

The test will take place at a location on McCallum Avenue, west of Adella (see map). Residents near the location will be notified prior to overnight activity.

The test will require continuous operation of a generator, beginning at 8 AM. Sound reduction walls will be used to minimize generator noise.

NEXT STEPS:

EPA contractors will sample for cleaning solvents such as TCE, PCE and 1,4-dioxane. EPA expects to complete this work by June. All materials and equipment will be removed.
