Anaconda Copper Mine Site Public Comment Period

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has proposed a voluntary settlement with Singatse Peak Services (SPS) for a portion of the ARIMETCO (Operable Unit 8) work at the Anaconda Copper Mine site.

Under the proposed agreement, SPS will fund a portion of EPA's work to restore capacity to the former Arimetco fluid management system, and will conduct a study of future needs. Atlantic Richfield is voluntarily funding an additional portion of the response. The public comment period for the proposed agreement ends on September 4, 2012.
