Community Update: Construction Planned for Summer of 2003


The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) invites you to attend a meeting on June 4, 2003, from 7:00 - 9:00 pm at the Davis Police Department, 2600 5th Street, in Davis, to discuss our plan to expand the groundwater cleanup system at the Frontier Fertilizer Superfund Site (Site). EPA will describe the results of the most recent field investigations at the Site and present our plans to expand the existing groundwater cleanup system. Construction is scheduled to begin in June 2003 and continue through September 2003.

Field activities scheduled for this summer include:

- installing four additional groundwater extraction wells to increase the amount of groundwater that is captured,
- installing new pipelines to convey water from the existing and new groundwater extraction wells to the treatment system, and
- installing one additional groundwater monitor well in the southern part of Mace Ranch.

Figure 1 shows proposed locations for the extraction and monitoring wells. With the exception of the new monitoring well, the remaining construction activities will take place outside of the Mace Ranch subdivision.

We are holding the public meeting to provide an opportunity for residents to find out more about the planned construction activities and provide input and ask questions before we finalize construction plans. State representatives will also be present.
