

CORRECTION RE: GTE OPERATIONS INC.

In Progress Report #3, EPA erroneously stated that "in 1999, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) measured trichlorethylene (TCE) in outdoor air concentrations ranging from 0.5 to 8.0 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ (microgram per meter cubed) in Mountain View." However, in 1999, TCE was NOT detected above 0.08 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ in outdoor air in Mountain View.

This error does not change our conclusion that indoor air in homes is safe, since we did not use BAAQMD outdoor air measurements as criteria for evaluating the health risk of TCE in indoor air. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused.
