What's Happening in the Neighborhood?

EPA completed the Remedial Investigation (RI) Field Work activities. These activities occurred from September 2004 to January 2006. We are evaluating the data to prepare a draft RI report. The RI report will be used to determine feasible alternatives to address the contamination at the Site. Even though we have necessary data to prepare the RI report, EPA will continue sampling the groundwater until remediation decision is made. The next groundwater sampling event will take place this month - June 2006. By the end of the summer, the groundwater data tables will be available to the public and at the repositories.

EPA is preparing a risk assessment as part of the Remedial Investigation. The risk assessment estimates the current and future health risks from the Site. The goal is to understand what degree of cleanup is needed.


