## Update on progress at the site

### Informational meeting planned


**You're invited** to an informational meeting and discussion of recent events regarding the Waste Disposal, Inc. Superfund site in Santa Fe Springs. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), the State of California's Department of Health Services (DHS), and the City of Santa Fe Springs are sponsoring the meeting. It will be held:

**Tuesday, January 14, 2003, in the Council Chambers at Santa Fe City Hall, 11710 Telegraph Road.**

The agencies will cover the following topics as well as answer questions and address concerns:

- The Public Health Assessment for the Waste Disposal Inc. Site — DHS
- The recently amended Record of Decision specifying the site cleanup plan — U.S. EPA
- The current status of site cleanup and upcoming actions — U.S. EPA
- Plans for redevelopment of the site — City of Santa Fe Springs

Contamination at the WDI site is the result of years of disposal of various wastes there when the site was used as a disposal area. Some of these now-buried wastes contained hazardous chemicals. After carefully studying the site, EPA has decided to cover the waste with an engineered cap to prevent water from percolating through the wastes and to install a gas collection system to control gas from the wastes. This will disturb the buried wastes as little as possible while ensuring that hazardous chemicals cannot reach people by moving through soil, air, or water.

As EPA conducts the cleanup, the City of Santa Fe Springs is planning for the possible future redevelopment of the site. The City is currently conducting a public design process and working with potential developers.
