
Dear Mr. Brawner:

In a letter dated September 24, 2007 regarding the Draft Final Third Five Year Review Report for Sacramento Army Depot dated August 2007, EPA deferred concurrence on the finding of continued protectiveness of the remedy. We requested additional information on vapor intrusion and the demonstration that vapor intrusion was not a concern at the Depot. In May 2008, the Army provided the requested information as Attachment 8 to the Final Third Five Year Review Report (Report), dated April 2008.

Additionally, EPA requested more information on the adequacy of institutional controls (ICs) at the site. The Army has since provided references to the documents in which ICs are described. These references are found in Attachment 2 to the Report.

With this additional information, EPA is now able to concur that the remedial actions implemented at the site continue to be protective of human health and the environment. Please contact Michael Work of my staff at 415-972-3024 if you have any questions.




