"We have been dealing with this problem for going on over two decades or we live in Henderson County and it is ridiculous I have a daughter that was born with neurological problems we get dizzy we get headaches we have health problems and they always told us our water was safe and they call it burn out but they have to do it by law but sometimes the water and our faucets and bathtubs smell exactly like the pool water does outside and this has been going on for over two decades and now not only does my daughter that was born here have neurological problems and several doctors that she has to see now me and my husband have health problems due to this and we were always told it was safe so what do we do about it because something needs to be done my brother and my sister also lives in the same neighborhood and other neighbors complain about it too sometimes it's not as strong sometimes it's so strong you can't stand it we buy bottled water two cases a month but still it's not enough we pay \$80 or more a month for our

water bill and they're charging us to make us sick”

There are a least three oil or gas wells within a 1/4 mile of my house and it is serviced by Auqa. Just last month we recieved a letter from Auqa saying our water may have been contaminated. My wife will be posting the letter in the near future”.
