Dear Jim and Angela,

I am much impressed with the changes in this draft. Table 1 goes a long way to answering why the EPA and the public should be concerned about reactive nitrogen.

I offer a few suggestions:

On page 1, in line 26, replace "In fact" with "Without a significant change in the dietary habits of wealthier countries, a large..."

On page 5, starting with line 12, the ideas presented here are not clear.

On page 10, lines 15 through 34, the relevance of the human diet to the release of reactive nitrogen should be discussed.

On page 11, line 5, The ideas in this sentence need to be better explained (i.e., "climate forcing" vis-à-vis "weather and climate effects").

On page 16, under first bullet, recommend the development of a systematic data base containing the morphology, use, and ecological status of wetlands, lakes, rivers, streams, shorelines and estuaries.
