

Hotlink to NRC Report on "Lessons Learned"

As a follow-up in response to a specific request from a RAC member during the July 12 public conference call, the U.S. EPA Office of Radiation and Indoor Air (ORIA) Staff obtained a publically available powerpoint presentation on "lessons learned" from the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission. The presentation by Elise A. Striz, Ph.D., Hydrogeologist in the Uranium Recovery and Licensing Branch of the U.S. NRC is entitled ***"ISR Application and Licensing Actions: Hydrogeology Lessons Learned."*** The "lessons learned" cover site characterization, ISR operation, restoration standards and hydrogeology and regulation of groundwater.

Specifically, the NRC staff stated:
