Hi Angela,

One of the public comments referred to a tool we were developing regarding cumulative impacts. We have completed it and it is called CalEnviroScreen 1.0. It is available at <http://www.oehha.ca.gov/ej/ces042313.html>

The information we have developed includes a report in English and Spanish, a free Google Earth application to view results in map format, a Microsoft Excel spreadsheet showing raw data and calculated percentiles for individual indicators, as well as combined CalEnviroScreen scores for individual ZIP codes, a zipped file which can be unzipped, then opened using ArcGIS software to view the results in a File Geodatabase Feature Class format, online maps with statewide and regional results, and public comments received and our responses to them. Feel free to distribute the information to committee members if you think it would be helpful. Also if you felt it would be helpful to present it to the board at some future meeting, I would be happy to do so.
