Subject: Notification of a Consultation on Phase Two of the Office of Policy, Planning, and Evaluation's Cumulative Exposure Model


Dear Ms. Browner:

The Integrated Human Exposure Committee (IHEC) of the Science Advisory Board (SAB) met on June 27, 1996, to conduct a consultation with staff from the Office of Policy, Planning, and Evaluation (OPPE) on their project to model cumulative human exposure to air, water, and food-borne agents. The SAB has developed the consultation as a mechanism to advise the Agency on technical issues that should be considered in the development of regulations, guidelines, or technical guidance before the Agency has taken a position. A consultation is conducted under the normal requirements of the Federal Advisory Committee Act, which include advance notice of the public meeting in the *Federal Register*.

As is our customary practice, there will be no formal report from the SAB as a result of this consultation, nor do we expect any formal response from the Agency.
