Hi Kathleen -

I'm not planning on participating in the conference call. However, I skimmed the draft report and I have an editorial comment. It concerns a sentence on page C3-110 that currently reads:
The implementation strategies may involve emissions controls on stationary sources, regulation of consumer products such as oil-based paints, vehicular traffic control, public transportation systems, as well as testing, inspections and maintenance of motor vehicles.

I'd like to suggest revising the sentence to read:
The implementation strategies may involve emissions controls on stationary sources, regulation of consumer products such as oil-based paints, and regulations or other programs to reduce emissions from motor vehicles and non-road equipment such as programs to reduce or eliminate idling of heavy-duty diesel vehicles and/or locomotives, programs to retrofit heavy-duty diesel vehicles and/or non-road equipment, transportation control measures, and requirements for the inspection and maintenance of motor vehicles.

Can you see that the comment gets to the appropriate person or should I forward it to someone else?
